Documents needed to present with LCAC Registration

To register for LCAC services, please provide the following documents:

- Photo ID for yourself
- Birth certificates or birth letters for all the children in the household.
- Proof of income (pay stubs, SNAP benefit letter, SSI letter)
- Current proof of address (current utility bill or other bill with your name or the name of someone in the household, within two months)
