- Food Distributions (Tues: 5pm-7pm, Wed: 11am-5pm, Th: 9am-11am)
- Vouchers for gently used clothing and household items for LCAC Clients (Lorton Attic Thrift Store- 9506 Richmond Hwy, Lorton VA 22079)
- Emergency financial assistance: Rent, Utilities and Vehicle Repair
- English Classes (Beginner and Intermediate levels)
- Workshops: Basic Computer, Job Readiness, Budgeting and more
- Nutrition Classes for Adults and Children
- Summer Programs for Kids
- Kids Educational Programs
- Seasonal Programs: Back to School, Holidays & Warm Coats

### **Required Documents to Complete Registration Form**

To register for LCAC services, please provide the following documents:

- **Photo ID** for **everyone** 18 or older in the household
- **Birth certificates** for children under 18 in the household
- **Proof of all income** for **all adults** in the household (Provide one of the following options for each adult)
  - 2-3 Paystubs (most recent pay periods)
  - Bank statement showing deposits (cross through any account numbers or sensitive information)
  - Copies of any benefit letters (SNAP, TANF, SSI, SSDI etc)
- **Proof of address** (Provide one of the following options)
  - Copy of lease or mortgage statement
  - Current utility bill
