## Required Documents to Complete Registration Form

To register for LCAC services, please provide the following documents:

- Photo ID for everyone 18 or older in the household
- Birth certificates for children under 18 in the household
- Proof of all income for all adults in the household (Provide one of the following options for each adult)
  - 2-3 Paystubs (most recent pay periods)
  - Bank statement showing deposits (cross through any account numbers or sensitive information)
  - Copies of any benefit letters (SNAP, TANF, SSI, SSDI etc)
- Proof of address (Provide one of the following options)
  - Copy of lease or mortgage statement
  - Current utility bill
